In addition, this technology downloads just a section of a large file, rather than an entire file, enabling users to immediately begin working on large files, rather than waiting for an entire download to complete.

## AUTOMATE BACKUP AND SYNCHRONIZATION TASKS

The GroupDrive<sup>.net</sup> Client offers an easy to use tool for automating backups and synchronizing folders between your PC and the GroupDrive<sup>.net</sup> Server. You can schedule backups to run on a daily, weekly or monthly schedule, and you can specify full or incremental backups. Once your files have been backed up to the server, they are easily accessible through the GroupDrive<sup>.net</sup> Client or Web Interface.

## SHARE FILES AND FOLDERS EASILY

Users can easily share files and folders, and can define the rights that others will have when accessing those files. When a folder has been shared with a user, they simply link to it and then view the folder and its contents as if it were stored right in their GroupDrive<sup>.net</sup> space.

Files and folders may also be shared with non GroupDrive<sup>.net</sup> users by emailing QuickLinks. In addition to defining specific access permissions, QuickLinks can be set up to require passwords and configured to expire after a certain time frame.

GroupDrive<sup>.net</sup> uses the Internet standard Web-based Distributed Authoring and Versioning (WebDAV) protocol for file access and collaboration. Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) encryption is used for securely transmitting files to and from the GroupDrive<sup>.net</sup> Server.
